Rules for Attaining Master Circle Status

Points are earned by acceptance into the juried IAPS exhibition and convention catalogue cover contest. Five (5) points total are required to obtain the status of IAPS Master Circle.

Points may be obtained in the following manner:

- One point for acceptance into a juried IAPS exhibition (whether the Web Exhibition or a physically-displayed Juried Exhibition), no matter the number of paintings accepted.
- One point for any award given by the judge in any juried IAPS exhibition.

Only IAPS Exhibitions accrue points; acceptance or awards in a member society's exhibition does not count towards Master Circle status.

The Master Circle Gold Medallions are presented at the convention, but artists who are advised that they have achieved sufficient points to be included in the Master Circle may begin listing the designation as soon as they are notified.
